

# **CARRIAGE OF GOODS BY LAND (CARRIERS' LIABILITIES) REPEAL BILL 1993**

## **EXPLANATORY NOTES**

*Clause 1* states the Short Title (Citation) of the Act.

*Clause 2* states the date of commencement of the Act which is a date to be proclaimed.

*Clause 3* provides for the repeal of the *Carriage of Goods by Land (Carriers' Liabilities) Act 1967*. Under the provisions of Section 20 of the *Acts Interpretation Act 1954* the liability of carriers for loss or damage incurred prior to proclamation of the Repeal Act would continue to be covered by the *Carriage of Goods by Land (Carriers' Liabilities) Act 1967*.

*Clause 4* provides a sunset clause for this Act. *The Carriage of Goods by Land (Carriers' Liabilities) Repeal Act* is to expire the day it commences.
