# APPROPRIATION BILL (No. 2) 1994

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

### GENERAL OUTLINE

#### Objectives of the Legislation

The objective of this Bill is to formally appropriate supplementary Supply for the services of the Crown in the 1993-94 financial year. The Supply sought is in addition to the amounts authorised in *Appropriation Act (No.2) 1993*.

The Bill is purely of a technical nature.

#### Reasons for the Bill

Supplementary Supply is required following approval by the Governor-in-Council of additional expenditure incurred during the previous financial year under Section 25 of the *Financial Administration and Audit Act 1977*.

#### Estimated Cost for Government Implementation

Not applicable. This authority involves the Parliamentary approval of supplementary appropriations for the 1993-94 financial year.

#### Consultation

The additional appropriation sought is based on the Statement of Unforeseen Expenditure to be Appropriated 1993-94 which is prepared by the Treasurer and certified by the Auditor-General in accordance with section 25A of the *Financial Administration and Audit Act 1977*.

**NOTES ON PROVISIONS**

*Clause 1* sets out the short title of the Bill.

*Clause 2* authorises the Treasurer to issue out of the public accounts, and apply for supplementing services in the financial year that started on 1 July 1993, the sum of \$650 645 000.
