1. This Act may be cited as the <i>Appropriation (Parliament) Act 2000</i> .	3
<b>Appropriation for 2000–2001</b>	4
2.(1) The Treasurer is authorised to pay \$49 952 000 from the consolidated fund for services of the Legislative Assembly and the Parliamentary Service for the financial year starting 1 July 2000. <sup>1</sup>	5 6 7
(2) The amount mentioned in subsection (1)—	8
(a) is appropriated for the financial year for the Legislative Assembly and the Parliamentary Service for application to their departmental outputs, equity adjustment and administered items as stated in the schedule; and	9 10 11 12
(b) includes amounts for departmental outputs, equity adjustment and administered items delivered by the Legislative Assembly and the Parliamentary Service in the financial year starting 1 July 1999 but for which they have not been paid in that financial year.	13 14 15 16
(3) The amount mentioned in subsection (1) includes the amount already authorised by the <i>Appropriation (Parliament) Act 1999</i> , section 4, to be paid for the financial year starting 1 July 2000.	17 18 19

3. The Treasurer is authorised to pay \$29 225 000 from the consolidated fund for services of the Legislative Assembly and the Parliamentary Service for the financial year starting 1 July 2001.	21 22 23
