

APPROPRIATION (PARLIAMENT) BILL (NO.2) 2001

EXPLANATORY NOTES

GENERAL OUTLINE

Policy Objectives of the Bill

The Bill provides supplementary appropriation for 2000-2001 for unforeseen expenditure that occurred in that financial year.

The supplementary appropriation sought is based on the Statement of Unforeseen Expenditure to be Appropriated 2000-2001 which has been prepared by the Treasurer and reported upon by the Auditor-General in accordance with Section 25A of the *Financial Administration and Audit Act 1977*.

NOTES ON PROVISIONS

Clause 1 provides for the short title of the Act.

Clause 2 (1) authorises the Treasurer to pay \$256,000 from the consolidated fund for the Legislative Assembly and parliamentary service for the financial year starting 1 July 2000.

Clause 2 (2) provides that the amount of \$256,000 is appropriated for the Legislative Assembly and parliamentary service for application to its departmental outputs for the financial year starting 1 July 2000.

LEGISLATIVE STANDARDS

Consultation

Consultation has been undertaken with the Legislative Assembly and parliamentary service in determining its supplementary appropriation requirement.
