**An Act to authorise the Governor in Council to make a gazette notice endorsing particular Commonwealth regulations for the *Trans-Tasman Mutual Recognition (Queensland) Act 1999***

*[Assented to 25 May 2001]*

## The Parliament of Queensland enacts—

### 1 Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Trans-Tasman Mutual Recognition (Queensland) Authorisation Act 2001*.

### 2 Definitions

In this Act—

“**Commonwealth Act**” means the *Trans-Tasman Mutual Recognition Act 1997* (Cwlth).

“**principal Act**” means the *Trans-Tasman Mutual Recognition (Queensland) Act 1999*.

### 3 Authorisation

The Governor in Council is authorised for section 5 of the principal Act to make, for the Commonwealth Act, section 43(1), a gazette notice in the form stated in the schedule.<sup>1</sup>

### 4 Expiry

This Act expires when the principal Act expires.<sup>2</sup>

1 Section 5 of the principal Act (Endorsing proposed regulations under the Commonwealth Act)

Section 43(1) of the Commonwealth Act—

**References to endorsing a proposed regulation**

**43.(1)** For the purposes of this Part, a jurisdiction endorses a regulation if the designated person for the jurisdiction publishes a notice in the official gazette of the jurisdiction setting out and endorsing the terms of the regulation before it is made.

2 Section 8 of the principal Act provides for its expiry.
