Cremations Regulation 2003

1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Cremations Regulation 2003*.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on the day section 19 of the Act commences.

3 Record of particulars for cremation to be kept

For section 14(1)(a) of the Act, the following particulars, to the extent they are given to the person in charge of a crematorium, are prescribed—

- (a) the deceased's name;
- (b) the deceased's age at death;
- (c) the date and place of the death;
- (d) the deceased's usual, or last known, place of residence;
- (e) the cremation date;
- (f) the date the permission to cremate was issued by the coroner or independent doctor;
- (g) the following particulars about how the ashes were disposed of—
 - (i) if the ashes were dealt with in accordance with section 11(1) of the Act—
 - (A) the details of the applicant's instructions; and
 - (B) the date and way in which the instructions were carried out;

- (ii) if the ashes were dealt with in accordance with section 11(2) of the Act—
 - (A) the date the notice under section 11(3) of the Act was given to the applicant; and
 - (B) the date and place of burial.
