1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Research Involving Human Embryos and Prohibition of Human Cloning Regulation 2003*.

2 Prescribed accrediting entity—Act, s 21

For section 21, definition *accredited ART centre* of the Act, the Reproductive Technology Accreditation Committee of the Fertility Society of Australia ACN 006 214 115, is a prescribed entity.

3 Prescribed guidelines to which NHMRC Licensing Committee must have regard—Act, s 29

For section 29(4)(c)¹ of the Act, the following guidelines are prescribed—

- (a) ‘Ethical Guidelines on the Use of Assisted Reproductive Technology in Clinical Practice and Research’, issued by the NHMRC in 2004;
- (b) ‘National Statement on Ethical Conduct in Research Involving Humans’, issued by the NHMRC in 1999.
