BILLS OF SALE AND OTHER INSTRUMENTS REGULATION 1996

[as amended by all amendments that commenced on or before 23 October 1998]

Short title

1. This regulation may be cited as the *Bills of Sale and Other Instruments Regulation 1996*.

Endorsement of instrument

2. A person applying for registration of an instrument must endorse on the instrument the class of instrument to which it belongs.

Register

3. The register of registered instruments under section 10 of the Act may be kept in 1 or more of the following ways—

- (a) on printed paper;
- (b) on microfiche;
- (c) on microfilm;
- (d) on magnetic tape;
- (e) in computer memory.

Fees

4. The fees payable under this Act are in the schedule.
