Short title

1. This notice may be cited as the *Nature Conservation (Macropod Harvest Period) Notice 1996*.

Commencement

2. This notice commences at midday on 3 June 1996.

Harvest period for whiptail wallaby

3. A harvest period for the whiptail wallaby starts at midday on 3 June 1996 and ends on 31 December 1996.

Where harvest period applies

4. The harvest period applies in all local government areas other than the areas of the local governments in the schedule.
