## **SECOND-HAND DEALERS AND COLLECTORS REGULATION 1994**

[reprinted as in force on 15 February 1994<sup>2</sup>]

### **Short title**

1. This regulation may be cited as the *Second-hand Dealers and Collectors Regulation 1994*<sup>3-4</sup>.

### **Commencement**

2. This regulation commences on 28 February 1994.

### **Forms**

3.(1) If a provision of the Act requires or permits a prescribed form to be used for a purpose—

- (a) the chief executive is to approve a form for the purpose; and
- (b) the form approved by the chief executive is the prescribed form for the purpose.

(2) A person may ask the chief executive for a document setting out the approved form for a purpose.

(3) The chief executive must promptly comply with the request.

### **Fees**

4. The fees payable under the Act are set out in the Schedule.

### **Licence must be signed**

5. Immediately after a person receives a licence issued to him or her, the person must sign the licence, in ink, in the space provided.

Maximum penalty—8 penalty units.

### **Register of licences**

**6.(1)** The chief executive must keep a register containing the current details of each licence issued.

**(2)** A person may inspect the register on payment of the relevant fee set out in the Schedule.

### **Display of licensed collector's name etc. on a vehicle**

**7.** For the purpose of section 31 of the Act, the letters used to display a licensed collector's name, the words 'licensed collector' and the licence number on a vehicle must be at least 50 mm high and written legibly.

### **Size and style of collector's badge**

**8.** A badge issued under section 32 of the Act must be—

- (a) silver with black writing; and
- (b) circular in shape with a diameter of at least 40 mm.

### **Register of transactions—collector**

**9.** For the purpose of section 34(2) of the Act, the following particulars are the prescribed particulars, relating to the collection or sale of second-hand goods, to be entered in a register of transactions—

- (a) the time and day of the collection or sale;
- (b) a description of the goods;
- (c) the name and address of the person from whom the goods were collected or to whom the goods were sold.

### **Register of transactions—dealer**

**10.** For the purpose of section 44(2) of the Act, the following particulars are the prescribed particulars, relating to the acquisition, sale or disposal of

second-hand goods, to be entered in a register of transactions—

- (a) the time and day of the acquisition, sale or disposal;
- (b) a description of the goods;
- (c) the name and address of the person from whom the goods were acquired or to whom the goods were sold or disposed of.
