## **TRADING (ALLOWABLE HOURS) REGULATION 1994**

### **Short title**

1. This regulation may be cited as the *Trading (Allowable Hours) Regulation 1994*<sup>3-4</sup>.

### **Commencement**

2. This regulation commences on 16 May 1994.

### **Declaration about answers**

3.(1) If a person is required to sign a declaration under under section 3.3(1)(c) of the Act, the inspector must—

- (a) write down the questions and answers when they are asked or made; and
- (b) write down the answers the person gives; and
- (c) read out the questions and answers to the person; and
- (d) allow the person to read the record; and
- (e) sign every page of the record of the questions and answers; and
- (f) attach the record to a declaration in the form approved by the chief executive.

(2) The person—

- (a) must cooperate with the inspector to make a true record; and
- (b) may change the record before signing the declaration; and
- (c) must sign the declaration when, and only if, the person is satisfied the record is correct.

**Objection to proposal to declare order obsolete**

4. A notice of objection under section 5.10(2) of the Act must be—
- (a) in the form approved by the chief executive; and
  - (b) filed with the Industrial Registrar within 30 days after publication of the notice of intention to declare the order obsolete.
