MARINE PARKS AMENDMENT REGULATIONS 1991

Short title

1. These regulations may be cited as the *Marine Parks Amendment Regulations 1991*.

Amended regulations

2. The *Marine Parks Regulations 1990* are amended as set out in these regulations.

Amendment of Schedule 1

3. Schedule 1—

(a) *omit* PART 1, *insert*—

‘PART 1 Fees payable in respect of assessment of tourist operation (regulations 5 and 9)

The following fees are prescribed for assessment of applications for permission to carry out activities in Marine Parks for the purpose of tourism or for purposes connected with tourism. Where an activity is referred to in more than 1 item, the fee payable is the fee for the item to which the higher or highest fee relates.

4.	Activity requiring preparation of an impact assessment study under regulation 9(4)(a)	\$21 490	\$2 680
5.	Any activity for the purpose of tourism or for a purpose connected with tourism not covered in items 1, 2, 3 or 4	\$370	\$370

(b) *omit* paragraph (a) of PART 2, *insert*—

‘(a) For issue or continuation of a permit for a commercial whale watching program—
