### Short title

**1.** This by-law may be cited as the *Medical Board of Queensland Amendment By-law 1992*.

### Amended by-law

**2.** The *Medical Board of Queensland By-law 1987* is amended as set out in this by-law.

**Replacement of s.1 (Short Title)****3.** Section 1—

**‘1.** This by-law may be cited as the *Medical Board of Queensland By-law 1987.*’.

**‘Waiver of fees**

**‘5A.** The annual licence fee is waived by the Board—

- (a) if a person is first registered as a medical practitioner before 1 October in any year—for that year; or
- (b) if a person is first registered as a medical practitioner after 1 October in any year—for that year and the following year; or
- (c) if a medical practitioner who is 70 years or older applies for waiver of the fee on or before 30 April in any year—for that year.’.

1. For registration as a medical practitioner (s.19(1) of the Act)	150
2. For registration as a specialist (s.22 of the Act)	100
3. For registration as a medical practitioner and a specialist at the same time (ss.19(1) and 22 of the Act)	200
4. Certificate of registration for the purpose of post-graduate tuition (s.20A of the Act)	100
5. Annual licence fee for medical practitioner (s.25 of the Act)	100
6. For insertion in a register of a higher degree, diploma, status or additional qualification (s.26 of the Act)	15
7. Restoration fee (one or both registers) (s.25 of the Act)	25’.
