Officials in Parliament Act 1896

PROCLAMATION

I, LENEEN FORDE, Governor—

- (a) declare that the following officers of the Crown liable to retire from office on political grounds are capable of being elected members of the Legislative Assembly and sitting and voting in the Legislative Assembly at the same time—
- Premier and Minister for Economic and Trade Development
 - Deputy Premier, Minister for Emergency Services and Consumer Affairs and Minister Assisting the Premier on Rural Affairs
 - Treasurer
 - Minister for Tourism, Sport and Racing
 - Minister for Education
 - Minister for Primary Industries
 - Minister for Police and Minister for Corrective Services
 - Minister for Housing, Local Government and Planning and Minister for Rural Communities
 - Minister for Health
 - Minister for Justice and Attorney-General and Minister for the Arts
 - Minister for Family Services and Aboriginal and Islander Affairs
 - Minister for Administrative Services

- Minister for Lands
 - Minister for Transport and Minister Assisting the Premier on Economic and Trade Development
 - Minister for Minerals and Energy
 - Minister for Employment, Training and Industrial Relations
 - Minister for Environment and Heritage
 - Minister for Business, Industry and Regional Development
- (b) revoke the proclamation made under section 3(1) of the Act on 16 December 1994 (1994 SL No. 477).
