Superannuation (Government and Other Employees) Act 1988

**SUPERANNUATION (GOVERNMENT AND
OTHER EMPLOYEES) NOTICE 1996**

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Short title

1. This notice may be cited as the *Superannuation (Government and Other Employees) Notice 1996*.

Commencement

2. This notice commences on 1 February 1996.

Definition

3. In this notice—

“**unit of the State public sector**” has the meaning given by the *Superannuation (State Public Sector) Act 1990*.

Persons approved to be members of scheme—Act, s 34A(1)(a)

4.(1) A person is approved to be a member of the scheme if subsections (2) and (3) apply to the person.

(2) This subsection applies to a person if the person—

- (a) is employed by or under the State; or
- (b) works under a contract with a unit of the State public sector that is wholly or principally for the person’s labour; or
- (c) holds, or performs the duties of, an appointment, office or position under a law of the State; or
- (d) is employed by an entity mentioned in schedule 1.

(3) This subsection applies to a person if the person—

- (a) regularly works at least 10 hours a week for the person’s employer and receives a regular salary for the employment; or
- (b) receives a yearly salary from the person’s employer that equals, or is at least, 50% of the tax-free threshold for taxation purposes under the *Income Tax Assessment Act 1936* (Cwlth); or

(c) receives a salary of at least \$450 a month.

(4) This section has effect subject to section 5.

Persons excluded from membership of scheme—Act, s 34A(1)(b)

5. A person mentioned in schedule 2 is excluded from membership of the scheme.

SCHEDULE 2

PERSONS EXCLUDED FROM MEMBERSHIP OF SCHEME

section 5

1. A member of the State Public Sector Superannuation Scheme.
2. A person who is—
 - (a) a person mentioned in section 4(2)(b) or (c); and
 - (b) a member of another superannuation scheme approved by the Minister.
3. A person who is—
 - (a) employed by Queensland Livestock and Meat Authority; and
 - (b) a member of the Livestock and Meat Authority Staff Superannuation Scheme
4. A person who is a Supreme or District Court judge.
5. A person who—
 - (a) is—
 - (i) a commissioner under the *Industrial Relations Act 1990*; or
 - (ii) a member of the Land Court; or
 - (iii) employed under the *Electricity Act 1994*; and
 - (b) is not a contributor to the State Service Superannuation Fund.
6. A person who—
 - (a) is an employee of, or engaged by, a unit of the State public sector, while on leave from other employment; and
 - (b) is a member of another superannuation scheme operated for the other employment and the State contributes, by agreement, to the

other scheme as the person's employer.

7. A person who—

(a) before 1 July 1991—

- (i) was employed by a university established under an Act; and
- (ii) has the status equivalent to, or higher than, a lecturer; and
- (iii) is eligible to contribute to a superannuation scheme for members of staff of the university; and
- (iv) is not a contributor to the State Service Superannuation Fund; or

(b) on or after 1 July 1991—

- (i) began employment with, or was engaged by, a university established under an Act; and
- (ii) is not a contributor to the State Service Superannuation Fund.

8. An officer of the Legal Aid Commission who is a contributor to the Commonwealth Superannuation Scheme established under the *Superannuation Act 1976 (Cwlth)*.
