PART 1—PRELIMINARY

1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Community Services Legislation Amendment Regulation (No. 1) 2003*.

2 Regulation amended in pt 2

This part amends the *Community Services (Aborigines) Regulation 1998*.

3 Insertion of new s 64C

Part 10A, after section 64B—

insert—

‘64C Criminal history checks

‘(1) For section 89(1)¹ of the Act, the chief executive may ask the commissioner of the police service to give the chief executive a written report about a person’s criminal history.²

‘(2) The commissioner must comply with the request.

‘(3) Subsection (1) applies to the criminal history in the commissioner’s possession or to which the commissioner has access.’.

4 Regulation amended in pt 3

This part amends the *Community Services (Torres Strait) Regulation 1998*.

5 Insertion of new s 64B

Part 11, before section 65—

insert—

‘64B Criminal history checks

‘(1) For section 87(1)³ of the Act, the chief executive may ask the commissioner of the police service to give the chief executive a written report about a person’s criminal history.⁴

‘(2) The commissioner must comply with the request.

‘(3) Subsection (1) applies to the criminal history in the commissioner’s possession or to which the commissioner has access.’.
