1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Introduction Agents Amendment Regulation (No. 1) 2004*.

2 Regulation amended

This regulation amends the *Introduction Agents Regulation 2002*.

3 Amendment of s 3 (Refund of fees)

Section 3(1)—

insert—

‘(c) a licensee applies for the replacement of a lost, stolen or destroyed licence and—

- (i) the chief executive refuses to replace the licence; or
- (ii) the licensee withdraws the application for the replacement of the licence before the chief executive has replaced, or refused to replace, the licence.’.

4 Amendment of s 5 (Statement to be included in an introduction agreement—Act, s 44(1)(b)(i))

(1) Section 5, heading, ‘s 44(1)(b)(i)’—

omit, insert—

‘s 44(1)(b)(iii)’.

(2) Section 5(1), ‘section 44(1)(b)(i)’ and footnote—

omit, insert—

‘section 44(1)(b)(iii)¹’.

Section 6(1), from ‘include—’ to ‘agreement—’

omit, insert—

‘include the following form of notice as the last page of the agreement—’.

6 Omission of s 7 (Licence to be conspicuously displayed)

Section 7—

omit.
