(2) Section 9(6), from ‘the person must satisfy’—

omit, insert—
‘the person must not have more than 4 children in the person’s custody.’

(3) Section 9(9), ‘section 7A(2)(e) to (g)’—

omit, insert—
‘section 7A(2)(e) and (f)’.
