**1 Short title**

This regulation may be cited as the *Radiation Safety Amendment Regulation (No. 1) 2005*.

**2 Regulation amended**

This regulation amends the *Radiation Safety Regulation 1999*.

**3 Amendment of s 9 (Certain use or transport licences—Act, s 75(3) and (4))**

- (1) Section 9, heading, ‘use’—

*omit, insert—*

‘**possession, use**’.

- (2) Section 9(1)(a), ‘NHMRC;’—

*omit, insert—*

‘NHMRC;<sup>1</sup>’.

- (3) Section 9(1)—

*insert—*

‘(d) a possession licence to possess or a use licence to use a sealed source apparatus for density-gauging or moisture-gauging for geo-technical purposes is subject to the condition that the holder of the licence comply with the document entitled ‘Code of Practice for Portable Density/Moisture Gauges Containing Radioactive Sources (2004)’ prepared by ARPANSA; and

(e) a possession licence to possess or a use licence to use a radioactive substance to carry out a diagnostic or therapeutic procedure involving irradiation of a person is subject to the condition that the holder of the licence comply with the document entitled ‘Recommendations

**4 Amendment of s 35 (Pregnant women—Act, ss 37(2)(c)(i), 41(5), 42(2), 127(1)(b), 132(4)(b), 133(2)(c) and 224(5)(c)(i))**

Section 35(3), 'for 127(1)(b)'—

*omit, insert—*

'for section 127(1)(b)'.

Section 36, 'section 37(2)(c)(ii)'—

'sections 37(2)(c)(ii)'.

**6 Amendment of sch 6 (Dictionary)**

(1) Schedule 6, definition *transport code of practice*—

*omit.*

(2) Schedule 6—

*insert—*

'**ARPANSA** means the Australian Radiation Protection and Nuclear Safety Agency.

***transport code of practice*** means the Code of Practice for the Safe Transport of Radioactive Material (2001)<sup>2</sup> published by ARPANSA.'

(3) Schedule 6, definition *equivalent dose*, 'prepared by NHMRC.'—
