3 Additional remuneration for each day or part of a day, after the 20th weekday, a person serves as a juror or reserve juror on a trial	33.00
4 Daily allowance under section 9(2)	100.00
5 Meal allowance if the jury is allowed to separate during a lunch adjournment to obtain a meal	10.50
6 Meal allowance if the jury is allowed to separate during an evening adjournment to obtain a meal	19.50’.
