# Workplace Health and Safety and Another Regulation Amendment Regulation (No. 1) 2009

## Subordinate Legislation 2009 No. 128

made under the

*State Penalties Enforcement Act 1999*  
*Workplace Health and Safety Act 1995*

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## Part 1 Preliminary

### 1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Workplace Health and Safety and Another Regulation Amendment Regulation (No. 1) 2009*.

### 2 Commencement

- (1) Section 21 commences on 1 September 2009.
- (2) The remaining provisions of this regulation commence on 1 July 2009.

- (ii) the nationally approved assessment instrument under the national standard; or
- (b) on or after 1 July 2010—the nationally approved assessment instrument under the national standard.’.

  - (b) the worker or person holds an earthmoving or particular crane work certificate for the occupation operator of a bridge and gantry crane in the circumstances mentioned in schedule 6, section 1(1)(a) and (b), and the load being lifted is lifted within the view of the worker or person.’.

- ‘(2) The unit of competency for the class is TLILIC808A: Licence to operate a slewing mobile crane (up to 20 tonnes).

**‘16 Slewing mobile crane with a capacity of 60t or less**

- ‘(1) The class of work is operator of a slewing mobile crane with a capacity of 60t or less.
- ‘(2) The unit of competency for the class is TLILIC908A: Licence to operate a slewing mobile crane (up to 60 tonnes).

**‘17 Slewing mobile crane with a capacity of 100t or less**

- ‘(1) The class of work is operator of a slewing mobile crane with a capacity of 100t or less.
- ‘(2) The unit of competency for the class is TLILIC1008A: Licence to operate a slewing mobile crane (up to 100 tonnes).

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**‘18 Slewing mobile crane with a capacity of more than 100t**

- ‘(1) The class of work is operator of a slewing mobile crane with a capacity of more than 100t.
- ‘(2) The unit of competency for the class is TLILIC1108A: Licence to operate a slewing mobile crane (over 100 tonnes).

**‘19 Materials hoist**

- ‘(1) The class of work is operator of a materials hoist with a cantilever platform.
- ‘(2) The unit of competency for the class is CPCCLHS3002A: Licence to operate a materials hoist.

**‘20 Materials or personnel hoist**

- ‘(1) The class of work is operator of a materials or personnel hoist.
- ‘(2) The unit of competency for the class is CPCCLHS3001A: Licence to operate a personnel and materials hoist.

- ‘(1) The class of work is operator of a boom-type elevating work platform with a boom length of 11m or more.
