# **Racing Regulation 2003**

[as amended by all amendments that commenced on or before 4 November 2005]

## **Part 1 Preliminary**

### **1 Short title**

This regulation may be cited as the *Racing Regulation 2003*.

### **2 Commencement**

This regulation commences on 1 July 2003.

## **Part 2 Matters about selection panels**

### **3 Establishment of selection panel as occasion requires**

- (1) For the purpose of selecting and appointing a person or persons as a member or members of the Thoroughbred Racing Board, or a member as the chairperson or deputy chairperson of the board, the Minister may establish a selection panel by giving written notice to each person the Minister selects for the panel.
- (2) The notice must state—
  - (a) the name and address of each person on the panel; and
  - (b) the position or positions on the Thoroughbred Racing Board for which a selection and appointment is required.
- (3) A selection panel must consist of 3 members.

- (4) In establishing a selection panel, the Minister must consult with the persons involved in the thoroughbred racing industry the Minister considers appropriate.

#### **4 Persons who are ineligible for selection panel**

A person is ineligible to be or to continue as a member of a selection panel if the person—

- (a) is affected by bankruptcy action; or
- (b) is, or has been, convicted of a criminal offence or an offence against the Act; or
- (c) becomes incapable of performing the duties of the member because of physical or mental incapacity; or
- (d) is subject to an exclusion action under a control body's rules of racing; or
- (e) is a participant licensed by the Thoroughbred Racing Board.

#### **5 Selection and appointment of board members**

In selecting and appointing a person as a member of the Thoroughbred Racing Board, a selection panel must have regard to—

- (a) the interests of the thoroughbred racing industry in the State; and
- (b) achieving a board membership with skills or experience in the following—
  - (i) business or financial management;
  - (ii) law;
  - (iii) leadership;
  - (iv) marketing;
  - (v) the thoroughbred racing industry.

## **6 Selection and appointment of chairperson or deputy chairperson of board**

- (1) In selecting and appointing a member of the Thoroughbred Racing Board as the chairperson or deputy chairperson of the board, a selection panel must consult with the members of the board.
- (2) A member may be selected and appointed as the chairperson or deputy chairperson only by a unanimous resolution of the selection panel.

## **Part 3 Country racing associations**

### **Division 1 Composition of country racing associations**

#### **7 Capricornia Country Racing Association**

- (1) The Capricornia Country Racing Association is comprised of the members nominated under subsection (2).
- (2) Each of the following may nominate 1 member—
  - (a) licensed trainers;
  - (b) racing bookmakers;
  - (c) licensed jockeys;
  - (d) each club mentioned in schedule 1, part 1.

#### **8 Central West Country Racing Association**

- (1) The Central West Country Racing Association is comprised of the members nominated under subsection (2).
- (2) Each of the following may nominate 1 member—
  - (a) licensed trainers;
  - (b) racing bookmakers;

- (c) licensed jockeys;
- (d) each club mentioned in schedule 1, part 2.

## **9 Downs Country Racing Association**

- (1) The Downs Country Racing Association is comprised of the the members nominated under subsection (2).
- (2) Each of the following may nominate 1 member—
  - (a) licensed trainers;
  - (b) racing bookmakers;
  - (c) licensed jockeys;
  - (d) each club mentioned in schedule 1, part 3.

## **10 Eastern Downs Country Racing Association**

- (1) The Eastern Downs Country Racing Association is comprised of the members nominated under subsection (2).
- (2) Each of the following may nominate 1 member—
  - (a) licensed trainers;
  - (b) racing bookmakers;
  - (c) licensed jockeys;
  - (d) each club mentioned in schedule 1, part 4.

## **11 Far North Country Racing Association**

- (1) The Far North Country Racing Association is comprised of the members nominated under subsection (2).
- (2) Each of the following may nominate 1 member—
  - (a) licensed trainers;
  - (b) racing bookmakers;
  - (c) licensed jockeys;
  - (d) each club mentioned in schedule 1, part 5.

**12 Leichardt Country Racing Association**

- (1) The Leichardt Country Racing Association is comprised of the members nominated under subsection (2).
- (2) Each of the following may nominate 1 member—
  - (a) licensed trainers;
  - (b) racing bookmakers;
  - (c) licensed jockeys;
  - (d) each club mentioned in schedule 1, part 6.

**13 North West Country Racing Association**

- (1) The North West Country Racing Association is comprised of the members nominated under subsection (2).
- (2) Each of the following may nominate 1 member—
  - (a) licensed trainers;
  - (b) racing bookmakers;
  - (c) licensed jockeys;
  - (d) each club mentioned in schedule 1, part 7.

**14 South East Country Racing Association**

- (1) The South East Country Racing Association is comprised of the members nominated under subsection (2).
- (2) Each of the following may nominate 1 member—
  - (a) licensed trainers;
  - (b) racing bookmakers;
  - (c) licensed jockeys;
  - (d) each club mentioned in schedule 1, part 8.

## **Division 2                      Nomination and appointment of members of country racing associations**

### **15            Nomination of certain members**

- (1) As soon as practicable after 27 February in each year in which nominations for members of a country racing association are to be made, the thoroughbred control body must invite licensed trainers, racing bookmakers and licensed jockeys to nominate a person for membership of the association.
- (2) If 1 person is nominated for membership of the country racing association by the licensed trainers, racing bookmakers or licensed jockeys, the person is nominated as the member for division 1.
- (3) If more than 1 person (each a *nominee*) is nominated for membership of the country racing association by the licensed trainers, racing bookmakers or licensed jockeys, the thoroughbred control body must conduct an election to decide the nominee who is nominated as the member for division 1.

### **16            Period for nomination of members**

The nomination of a person as a member of a country racing association must be made after 27 February and before 1 July in each year in which nominations are to be made.

### **16A          Appointment of member of country racing association**

- (1) A person nominated as a member of a country racing association for division 1 is appointed a member of the association on 1 August in the year the nomination is made.
- (2) A member of a country racing association is eligible for renomination and reappointment as a member.

### **16B          Term of office**

A member of a country racing association holds office for 2 years starting on the day the member is appointed.

**16C Revocation of nomination by club**

A club mentioned in schedule 1 may revoke its nomination of a person as a member of a country racing association only if at least three-quarters of the club's members or, if three-quarters is not a whole number, the next highest whole number of its members, agree to revoke the nomination.

**16D Vacation of office**

The office of a member of a country racing association becomes vacant if—

- (a) the member dies; or
- (b) the member becomes incapable of continuing as a member; or
- (c) the member resigns by signed notice given to the association; or
- (d) the member is absent from 3 consecutive meetings of the association and is not excused by the chairperson of the association for the absences at any time before the end of the next meeting after the third absence; or
- (e) for a member of the association nominated by a club mentioned in schedule 1—
  - (i) the club gives the chairperson of the association notice that the member's nomination has been revoked under section 16C; or
  - (ii) the club ceases to be a club mentioned in schedule 1 for the association.

**16E Casual vacancies**

- (1) This section applies if the office of a member (the *previous member*) of a country racing association becomes vacant, otherwise than under section 16D(e)(ii).
- (2) If a club mentioned in schedule 1 nominated the previous member, the club may nominate another person (the *replacement member*) for membership of the country racing association.



**18 Witness fees and expenses—Act, s 178**

- (1) For section 178(1)(a)<sup>2</sup> of the Act, the witness fees and expenses are the following—
  - (a) an attendance allowance of \$51.45 for each day or part of a day;
  - (b) a travelling allowance;
  - (c) an accommodation allowance.
- (2) If the person travels to and from the racing appeals tribunal by air and it is reasonable in the circumstances to travel by air, the travelling allowance is the amount payable for economy class air travel by the person to and from the tribunal.
- (3) If subsection (2) does not apply, the travelling allowance is—
  - (a) the amount actually and properly paid for fares for public transport to and from the tribunal; or
  - (b) if there is no public transport available—\$10.50 for each day or part of a day plus an amount worked out at the rate of 40c a kilometre travelled.
- (4) If the person is required to attend at the tribunal for more than 1 day and it is not reasonably practicable for the person to return to the person's place of residence on any day on which the person is required to attend at the tribunal, the accommodation allowance is \$94.55 for each overnight stay.

**Part 5 Miscellaneous****19 Due date for the yearly fee payable by a control body—Act, s 29**

For section 29(2)(b)<sup>3</sup> of the Act, the fee relating to each year for which a control body's approval has effect is payable by

each anniversary of the approval effect day for the control body.

**20 Publication by integrity board of analytical procedures—Act, s 115**

- (1) For section 115(3)(b)<sup>4</sup> of the Act, the integrity board may publish analytical procedures and amendments of the procedures by—
- (a) making the procedures and amendments available for inspection, free of charge, at its business address during its ordinary office hours and on a website; and
  - (b) giving a copy of the procedures or amendments to a person if the person asks for a copy.
- (2) In this section—

*analytical procedures* means the procedures developed or adopted by the integrity board, under section 115(3)(a) of the Act, about the way things for analysis are to be taken and dealt with.

**21 Qualifications for an accredited analyst—Act, s 129**

For section 129(3)(b)<sup>5</sup> of the Act, the qualifications to be an accredited analyst are a qualification awarded by a tertiary institution in the field of analytical chemistry or a similar field.

**22 Approved place for paying and settling certain bets—Act, s 254**

For section 254(2)<sup>6</sup> of the Act, Tattersall's Club Rooms at 215 Queen Street, Brisbane is approved for the payment and settlement of a bet.

**23 Prescribed laws about racing or betting**

**24 Fees**

The fees payable under the Act are stated in schedule 3.

(No. 1) 2005****25 First appointment of members of country racing associations**

- (1) This section applies despite sections 15 to 16B.
- (2) As soon as practicable after the commencement—
  - (a) each club mentioned in schedule 1 may nominate a person as a member of the country racing association for which the club may nominate a member for part 3, division 1; and
  - (b) the thoroughbred control body must invite licensed trainers, racing bookmakers and licensed jockeys to nominate a person for membership of each country racing association.
- (3) If 1 person is nominated for membership of the country racing association by the licensed trainers, racing bookmakers or licensed jockeys, the person is nominated as the member for part 3, division 1.
- (4) If more than 1 person (each a *nominee*) is nominated for membership of the country racing association by the licensed trainers, racing bookmakers or licensed jockeys, the thoroughbred control body must conduct an election to decide the nominee who is nominated as the member for part 3, division 1.

*Racing Regulation 2003*

- (5) A person nominated as a member of a country racing association under this section—
- (a) is, on nomination, appointed as a member of the country racing association; and
  - (b) holds office until the end of 31 July 2007.
- (6) In this section—
