Table of changed names and titles in legislation

What is the table of changed names and titles

Legislation is frequently amended or replaced and, as a result, the names of things may be changed or existing things may be replaced by other things (e.g. the name of an authority changed or an authority replaced by another authority). It can be difficult for users of legislation to keep track of changes and work out what is the current name of something in legislation. This table aims to help users by listing in 1 place names of things that have changed.

This table only relates to those occasions when a reference to a name or title has been replaced by legislation that specifically allows a reference to the name or title to be taken to be a reference to the new name or title or that otherwise makes provision for the change.

How names and titles are changed

When legislation is amended or replaced, if existing references to the names of things are not amended consequentially, the references become out of date. Sometimes, under particular authorising provisions of legislation, an existing reference to a thing may, if the context permits, be taken as a reference to a later name of the same thing or the name of a different thing.

How is it done

Listed in the table, separated into three columns, are—

- column 1 (old)—the **old name or title** that has been changed or is otherwise out of date
- column 2 (new)—the **new name or title** that replaces the out-of-date reference
- column 3 (authorising provision)—the **authorising provision** (if any) that deems a reference to the old name or title in column 1 to be a reference to the different name or title in column 2.

Additional information

Information in round brackets

Information in round brackets (‘()’) indicates alternatives or additional words that may be required in some contexts. For example, the term may not always appear in the exact form that appears in the table.

Example—

The following references are taken from the table. The words in brackets may not always be necessary in the new reference or may indicate that other references may be changed—

- licence to hire-private hire car (under the State Transport Act 1960)
- member (of the police force)
- person of unsound mind (or a similar term).

Information in round brackets may be part of an appropriate replacement reference.

Information in square brackets

Information in square brackets (‘[]’) is included for information only.

Example—

In the following reference provisions, the information inside the square brackets is for information purposes only—

- Electricity Act 1994 s 286(1) [Note: This reference provision applies unless the context or a regulation otherwise provides.]
- Local Government Act 1993 s 755(1)(e) [Note: The new reference includes the president of a joint local government.]

Information in square brackets (in blue) in column 3 indicates where the associated reference provision can be found.

Example—

In the following reference provision, the information inside the square brackets indicates the reference can be found in the 2004 Annual Volumes, p 369—

- Legal Profession Act 2004 s 601 [2004 A.V. p 369]

If the information contained in the square brackets indicates that the reference provision has not commenced, the provision should be checked to make sure it has not commenced since the issue of this table.

Reference provisions no longer current

Some replacement names and titles themselves have expired or been repealed or replaced. Also, a relevant thing may have been abolished without replacement. However, this does not result in the relevant name in the table being changed or updated as it is intended to be the original record of the change and is to remain permanently in the table in its original form.
