Queensland Legislation Annotations—repealed volume

The Queensland Legislation Annotations is the major legislative information publication produced by the Office of the Queensland Parliamentary Counsel. It allows the history of Queensland legislation to be easily researched.

- 1 Alphabetical table of repealed Queensland legislation lists Queensland legislation that has been repealed.
includes weekly updates displaying changes made to repealed Queensland legislation
- 2 Chronological table of repealed Queensland Act lists Queensland Acts that were repealed.
includes weekly updates displaying changes made to repealed Queensland Acts
- 3 Alphabetical table of NSW legislation no longer applying in Queensland.
- 4 Alphabetical table of Imperial legislation no longer applying in Queensland.

Weekly changes

Weekly changes made to Queensland legislation can be found under each appropriate heading. Changes for the week are identified by—

- the changed text is highlighted in red
- a sidebar appears on the left hand side against the changed text
- bookmarks appearing on the left-hand side of the file display only the changed text

Underlined and numbered text

Any text underlined means the repealing legislation has not yet commenced.

The number appearing on the right hand side (after the dot leaders) refers to the last issue of the Queensland Legislation Annotation (current), in which historical legislative information can be found before the legislation is repealed.
