# MEAT INDUSTRY REGULATION 1994

[as amended by all amendments that commenced on or before 17 February 1995]

## PART 1—PRELIMINARY

### Short title

1. This regulation may be cited as the *Meat Industry Regulation 1994*.

### Animals to which Act does not apply—Act, s 7(3)

2. Animals other than warm blooded vertebrates and reptiles are declared to be animals to which the Act does not apply.

### Prohibited animals—Act, s 54(2)

3. A prohibited animal is of the species—
  - (a) canine; or
  - (b) feline.

## PART 2—TRANSITIONAL\*

### *Declaring assets, rights and liabilities of the Authority—Act, s 169(1)*

*4.(1) The assets, rights and liabilities identified by the working trial balance as the assets, rights and liabilities of the former Authority are declared to be the assets, rights and liabilities of the Authority.*

*(2) In this section—*

**“working trial balance”** means the document entitled ‘Livestock and Meat Authority of Queensland Working Trial Balance as at 1 January 1994’ generated by the Authority with a computer on 13 January 1994.<sup>1</sup>

- (b) *expires on the changeover day.\**

**5.(1)** *The employees named in the Schedule become employees of the Authority.*
