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Supreme Court Regulation 1998

[as amended by all amendments that commenced on or before 22 April 2005]

1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Supreme Court Regulation 1998*.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on 1 July 1998.

3 Districts and registries for the Act, pt 19

- (1) The districts in the schedule, column 1 are established as Supreme Court Districts.
- (2) Each Supreme Court district consists of the Magistrates Courts district or districts named in the schedule, column 2 opposite the Supreme Court district.
- (3) A Supreme Court registry is established at each place from which the Supreme Court district takes its name.

Example—

The Toowoomba Supreme Court district takes its name from Toowoomba.

4 Rate of interest on debt under judgment or order

For section 48(1)¹ of the Act, the prescribed rate is 10% a year.
