are repealed, and the following provision is inserted in lieu thereof:—

Given for or upon the payment of money—

Amounting to one pound or upwards, but less than two pounds	0 0 1
Amounting to two pounds or upwards, but less than fifty pounds	0 0 2
Amounting to fifty pounds or upwards, but less than one hundred pounds	0 0 3
Amounting to one hundred pounds or upwards, for every one hundred pounds or fraction of one hundred pounds	0 0 6

Duration of

3. The provisions of this Act shall cease to have effect on the first day of October, one thousand nine hundred and three.

An Act to Further Amend “The Supreme Court Act of 1874.”

[ASSENTED TO 17TH SEPTEMBER, 1901.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Queensland in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title and
 construction.

1. This Act may be cited as “*The Chief Justice's Salary Act of 1901*,” and shall be read and construed with and as an amendment of “*The Supreme Court Act of 1874*.”*

Salary of
 Chief Justice.

2. From and after the commencement of this Act the salary of the Chief Justice of Queensland shall be at the rate of two thousand five hundred pounds per annum.

Commence-
 ment of Act.

3. This Act shall commence and take effect on and from the next appointment of a Chief Justice of Queensland.

Repeal of
 56 Vic. No. 32.

4. From and after the commencement of this Act “*The Chief Justice's Salary Act of 1892*”† shall be repealed.
