An Act to Further Amend "The Supreme Court Act of 1874."

No. 2. THE CHIEF JUSTICE'S SALARY ACT or 1901.

[Assented to 17th September, 1901.]

)E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Queensland in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :----

1. This Act may be cited as "The Chief Justice's construction. Salary Act of 1901," and shall be read and construed with and as an amendment of "The Supreme Court Act of 1874."*

2. From and after the commencement of this Act the Chief Justice. salary of the Chief Justice of Queensland shall be at the rate of two thousand five hundred pounds per annum.

3. This Act shall commence and take effect on and ment of Act. from the next appointment of a Chief Justice of Queensland.

4. From and after the commencement of this Act Repeal of 56 Vic. No. 32. " The Chief Justice's Salary Act of 1892" + shall be repealed
