# An Act to Amend the "Acts Shortening Act of 3 Edw. VII. 1867," and for other purposes. THE ACTS

THE ACTS SHORTENING AOT AMENDMENT ACT OF 1903.

[Assented to 13th November, 1903.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Queensland in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :--

1. This Act may be cited as "The Acts Shortening Short titleand Act Amendment Act of 1903," and shall be read and con-construction. strued with and as an amendment of the "Acts Shortening Act of 1867,"\* hereinafter called the Principal Act. This Act and that Act may be cited together as "The Acts Shortening Acts."

#### Amendments of Principal Act.

2. Sections two and three of the Principal Act are Repeal repealed, and the following sections are inserted in lieu of 31 Vic. No. 6, 88. 2, 3. thereof :--

[2.] (i.) The repeal of an Act or part thereof by which Effect of a previous Act or part thereof was repealed shall not have  $\frac{152 & 53 \text{ Vict.}}{152 & 53 \text{ Vict.}}$ the effect of reviving such last-mentioned Act or part c. 63, ss. 11, thereof without express words.

(ii.) Where an Act repeals in the whole or in part a former Act, then, unless the contrary intention appears, the repeal shall not—

(a) Revive anything not in force or existing at the time at which the repeal takes effect; or

- (b) Affect the previous operation of any Act so repealed, or anything duly done or suffered under any Act so repealed; or
- (c) Affect any right, privilege, obligation, or liability acquired, accrued, or incurred under any Act so repealed; or
- (d) Affect any penalty, forfeiture, or punishment incurred in respect of any offence committed against any Act so repealed; or
- (e) Affect any investigation, legal proceeding, or remedy in respect of any such right, privilege, obligation, liability, penalty, forfeiture, or punishment as aforesaid;

and any such investigation, legal proceeding, or remedy may be instituted, continued, or enforced, and any such penalty, forfeiture, or punishment may be imposed, as if the repealing Act had not been passed.

(iii.) Where an Act repeals in the whole or in part a former Act and substitutes provisions in lieu thereof, the repealed provisions shall, unless the contrary intention appears, remain in force until the substituted provisions come into operation.

(iv.) Where an Act repeals and re-enacts with or without modification any provisions of a former Act, references in any other Act to the provisions so repealed shall, unless the contrary intention appears, be construed as references to the provisions so re-enacted.

[3.] The expiration of an Act shall not affect any civil proceeding previously commenced under such Act. but every such proceeding may, unless the contrary intention appears in such Act, be continued and everything in relation thereto be done in all respects as if the Act continued in force.

**3.** After section seven of the Principal Act, the following section is inserted :---

 $[7_{A}]$  When an Act is not to come into operation immediately on the passing thereof, and confers power to make any appointment, to make, grant, or issue any instrument (including any rules, regulations, or by-laws), to give notices, to prescribe forms, or to do any other thing [52 & 53 Vict. for the purposes of the Act, that power may, unless the contrary intention appears, be exercised at any time after the passing of the Act for the purpose of bringing the Act into operation at the commencement thereof:

Provided that any instrument made under the power shall not, unless the contrary intention appears in the Act, or the contrary is necessary for bringing the Act into operation, come into operation until the Act comes into operation.

4. The following provisions are added to section eleven Amendment of 31 Vic. of the Principal Act :---

Expressions referring to writing shall, unless the "Writing." contrary intention appears, be construed as including  $\begin{bmatrix} 52 & 53 & \text{Vict.} \\ c. & 63, s. & 20. \end{bmatrix}$  references to printing, lithography, photography, and other references to printing, lithography, photography, and other modes of representing or reproducing words in a visible form.

Where an Act whenever passed authorises or requires service by any document to be served by post, whether the expression post. "serve" or the expression "give" or "send" or any other c. 63, s. 26.] expression is used, then, unless the contrary intention appears, the service shall be deemed to be effected by properly addressing, prepaying, and posting a letter containing the document, and, unless the contrary is proved, to have been effected at the time at which the letter would be delivered in the ordinary course of post.

5. After section twelve of the Principal Act, the following section is inserted :---

[12A.] Where any Act whenever passed confers power Construction to make, grant, or issue any instrument—that is to say, of statutory any proclamation, Order in Council, order, warrant, letters [32 & 53 Vict. patent, commission, rules, regulations, or by-laws-expres- a. 63, s. 31.] sions used in the instrument shall, unless the contrary intention appears, have the same respective meanings as in the Act conferring the power.

6. In section nineteen of the Principal Act after the Amendment of 31 Vic. word "orders" the word "by-laws" is inserted. No. 6, s. 19.

7. After section twenty-nine of the Principal Act, the following section is inserted :---

[29A.] (1.) When by any Act whenever passed any Printing of section or schedule or any word or words is or are directed amendments in Acta. to be inserted in or omitted from any previous Act or any section or schedule thereof, or to be substituted for or inserted in lieu of any section or schedule, or any word or words forming part or the whole of any section or schedule of any previous Act, then in all copies of the Act so amended printed by the Government Printer the section or schedule or word or words shall be inserted or omitted or substituted in accordance with such direction, and all necessary consequential amendments of marginal notes,

headings, and divisions shall be made. And references shall be made in the margin to the section or sections of the Act by which such amendments are made :

Provided that no amendment shall merely by force of such direction have any retrospective operation.

(2.) Whenever any enactment in any Act relating to the practice or procedure of the Supreme Court has been or shall hereafter be in pursuance of statutory authority in that behalf abrogated by Rules of the Supreme Court, then in all copies of such Act printed by the Government Printer the enactment so abrogated shall be omitted, and reference shall be made in the margin to the Rule of Court whereby such abrogation was made.

#### Short Titles.

8. (1.) Each of the Acts mentioned in the First Schedule to this Act may, without prejudice to any other mode of citation, be cited by the short title therein mentioned in that behalf.

(2.) Each of the groups of Acts mentioned in the groups of Acts Second Schedule to this Act may, without prejudice to any other mode of citation, be cited by the collective title therein mentioned in that behalf.

> If any Act passed after this Act is directed to be read with any of the groups of Acts mentioned in the Second Schedule to this Act, that group shall be construed as including that Act, and the year in which that Act is passed shall be substituted for the last year stated in the collective title of the group and so on as often as a subsequent Act is added to the group.

> 9. Whenever a proposed Act having passed both Houses of Parliament is then reserved for His Majesty's assent, and such assent is not proclaimed in the same year in which such proposed Act was so reserved, such Act shall be cited in the short title thereof as of the year in which such assent was proclaimed, notwithstanding that the short title in the said Act is stated to be of a different year, and such short title shall be amended accordingly.
