An Act to Amend The Legislative Assembly Acts 1867 to 1946 and The Constitution Act Amendment Act of 1922, each in a certain particular and to repeal The Constitution Act Amendment Act of 1935

[ASSENTED TO 14TH APRIL, 1971]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Queensland in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1. Short title and citation. (1) This Act may be cited as the Legislative Assembly Act Amendment Act 1971.
- (2) The Legislative Assembly Act of 1867 as subsequently amended and as amended by this Act may be collectively cited as the Legislative Assembly Act 1867-1971.

- 2. Repeal of s. 3. Legislative Assembly Act 1867. The Legislative Assembly Act of 1867 as subsequently amended is further amended by repealing section 3.
- 3. Repeal of s. 3. Constitution Act Amendment Act 1922. The Constitution Act Amendment Act of 1922 is amended by repealing section 3.
- 4. Repeal of Constitution Act Amendment Act 1935. The Constitution Act Amendment Act of 1935 is repealed.
