An Act to Amend the Commonwealth Places (Administration of Laws) Act 1970 in certain particulars

[ASSENTED TO 16TH DECEMBER, 1971]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Queensland in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1. Short title and citation. (1) This Act may be cited as the Commonwealth Places (Administration of Laws) Act Amendment Act 1971.
- (2) The Commonwealth Places (Administration of Laws) Act 1970 is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- (3) The Principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Commonwealth Places (Administration of Laws) Act 1970-1971.

^{2.} Amendment of s. 4. Section 4 of the Principal Act is amended by, in subsection (1), omitting the expression "(not being a court)" where it twice occurs.

^{3.} Amendment of s. 15. Section 15 of the Principal Act is amended by, in subsection (1), omitting the word "seventy-one" and inserting in its stead the word "seventy-two".
