Major Sports Facilities Amendment Act 2011

Act No. 28 of 2011

**An Act to amend the Major Sports Facilities Act 2001 for particular purposes
[Assented to 8 September 2011]**

The Parliament of Queensland enacts—

1 Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Major Sports Facilities Amendment Act 2011*.

2 Commencement

This Act commences, or is taken to have commenced, on 8 September 2011.

3 Act amended

This Act amends the *Major Sports Facilities Act 2001*.

4 Insertion of new pt 3B

After section 30AH—

insert—

‘Part 3B Major sport events at Suncorp Stadium

‘Division 1 Major sport events during 2011

‘30AI Definitions for div 1

In this division—

major sport event means a national or international sport event that has a crowd size of more than 35000.

relevant development approval means the development approval relating to the major sports facility called ‘Suncorp Stadium’ issued under the *Integrated Planning Act 1997* on 6 July 2001 and continued as a development approval under the *Sustainable Planning Act 2009*.

relevant development approval condition means condition 42 of the relevant development approval, a copy of which is set out in schedule 1A.

‘30AJ Application of div 1

This division applies to major sport events held between 1 January 2011 and 31 December 2011 at the major sports facility called ‘Suncorp Stadium’.

‘30AK Major sport events between 1 January 2011 and 31 December 2011

- ‘(1) Subject to compliance with the conditions of the relevant development approval, other than the relevant development approval condition, the use of Suncorp Stadium for no more than 24 major sport events between 1 January 2011 and 31 December 2011 is a lawful use of the facility.
- ‘(2) Subsection (1) applies despite the relevant development approval condition, the *Sustainable Planning Act 2009*, any provision of the relevant planning scheme, any development approval or compliance permit under that Act relating to the facility and any condition attached to the approval or permit.
- ‘(3) This section applies despite division 2.

‘Division 2 Major sport events after 2011

‘30AL Definitions for div 2

In this division—

major sport event means a national or international sport event that has a crowd size of more than the number prescribed by regulation.

relevant development approval see section 30AI.

relevant development approval condition see section 30AI.

‘30AM Application of div 2

This division applies to major sport events held at the major sports facility called ‘Suncorp Stadium’.

‘30AN Use of Suncorp Stadium for major sport events

- ‘(1) Subject to compliance with the conditions of the relevant development approval, other than the relevant development approval condition, the use of Suncorp Stadium for no more than 24 major sport events each year is a lawful use of the facility.
- ‘(2) Subsection (1) applies despite the relevant development approval condition, the *Sustainable Planning Act 2009*, any provision of the relevant planning scheme, any development approval or compliance permit under that Act relating to the facility and any condition attached to the approval or permit.’.

5 Insertion of new sch 1A

After schedule 1—

insert—

'Schedule 1A Relevant development approval condition
