Act No. 46 of 2012

An Act to amend the Parliament of Queensland Act 2001 for a particular purpose

[Assented to 11 December 2012]

The Parliament of Queensland enacts—

1 Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Parliament of Queensland (Registered Political Parties) Amendment Act 2012*.

2 Commencement

This Act commences, or is taken to have commenced, on 29 November 2012.

3 Act amended

This Act amends the *Parliament of Queensland Act 2001*.

4 Amendment of s 112 (Additional salary entitlement of some members)

Section 112(3)(b)—

omit, insert—

‘(b) a registered political party if—

- (i) at least 3 Assembly members are party members and were party members at the most recent election at which the party member was elected as an Assembly member; and
- (ii) for the most recent general election, the total number of first preference votes for all candidates who were party members was at least 10% of the total number of first preference votes for all candidates.’.
