**An Act to amend the Queensland Reconstruction Authority Act 2011 for
particular purposes**

[Assented to 19 February 2013]

The Parliament of Queensland enacts—

1 Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Queensland Reconstruction Authority Amendment Act 2013*.

2 Act amended

This Act amends the *Queensland Reconstruction Authority Act 2011*.

3 Amendment of s 2 (Main purpose of Act)

Section 2, from ‘to ensure’—

omit, insert—

‘—

- (a) to ensure Queensland and its communities effectively and efficiently recover from the impacts of disaster events; and
- (b) to improve the resilience of communities for potential disaster events.’.

4 Amendment of s 6 (Meaning of *disaster event*)

Section 6—

insert—

‘(ba) the storms, tornadoes and floods caused by ex-tropical cyclone Oswald and associated heavy rains in January and February 2013;’.

5 Amendment of s 10 (Authority’s functions)

Section 10(1)—

insert—

- ‘(i) to plan for, coordinate and put in place measures to improve the resilience of communities for potential disaster events.’.

6 Amendment of s 139 (Expiry)

Section 139, ‘30 June 2014’—

omit, insert—

‘30 June 2015’.
