15 Particular public holiday in 2022

- A public holiday is to be observed on 22 September 2022 for the National Day of Mourning for Her Majesty The Queen.
- (2) To remove any doubt, it is declared that a reference in an industrial instrument under the *Industrial Relations Act 2016* to a public holiday is taken, for 2022, to include the day mentioned in subsection (1).
