DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORT (VARIATION OF FEES) REGULATION 1993

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Short title

1. This regulation may be cited as the *Department of Transport* (Variation of Fees) Regulation 1993.

Commencement

2. This regulation commences on 1 July 1993.
