#### Short title

1. This regulation may be cited as the Department of Transport (Repeal of Penalty Notice Provisions) Regulation 1994.

#### Commencement

**2.(1)** This regulation commences on 12 December 1994.

## Definition

**3.** In this regulation—

"transport regulation" means any of the following-

- (a) Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road Regulation 1989;
- (b) *State Transport Regulation 1987*;
- (c) *Tow Truck Regulation 1988*;
- (d) *Traffic Regulation 1962*;
- Transport Infrastructure (Roads) Regulation 1991. (e)

## **Transport regulations amended**

4. Each transport regulation is amended by the Schedule for the regulation.

## Transitional

5. Despite the repeal of a provision of a transport regulation by this regulation, the provision continues to apply to a notice issued under the provision that is a notice-

(a) to which section 269 of the Justices Act 1886<sup>1</sup> applies; or

Section 269 was inserted in the Justices Act 1886 by the Offence Notices 1 Legislation Amendment Act 1994. The section provides for transitional provisions for SETONS.

(b) that is an infringement notice under section 18 of the *Justices Regulation 1993.*<sup>2</sup>

#### **Expiry of regulation**

**6.** This regulation expires on the day sections 269 and 270 of the *Justices Act 1886* expire.
