Short title

1. This regulation may be cited as the *Justices Amendment Regulation* (*No. 3*) 1998.

2. This regulation amends the *Justices Regulation 1993*.

Insertion of new ss 19 and 20

3. After section 18—

insert—

'Postponed commencement of uncommenced provision—the Act, s 147A

'19.(1) In this section—

- "postponed law" means the *Justice and Other Legislation (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act (No. 2) 1997*, section 60.1
- '(2) The period before automatic commencement, under the *Acts Interpretation Act 1954*, section 15DA(2), of the postponed law is extended to the end of 30 November 1999.²

'20.(1) In this section—

"postponed law" means the Justice and Other Legislation (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act (No. 2) 1997, section 61.3

Justice and Other Legislation (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act (No. 2) 1997, section 60 (Amendment of s 147A (Powers of justices to reopen proceedings and rectify orders)) amends the Justices Act 1886.

The postponed law now automatically commences on 1 December 1999.
