**‘Transitional provisions for offences against repealed part**

**‘425.(1)** Proceedings for an offence against the repealed part may be started or continued, and the provisions of the repealed part and the *Health Act 1937* that are necessary or convenient to be used in relation to the proceedings continue to apply, as if the *Health Amendment Regulation*

(No. 4) 1999 had not commenced.

‘(2) For subsection(1), the *Acts Interpretation Act 1954*, section 20<sup>1</sup> applies, but does not limit the subsection.

‘(3) In this section—

“**repealed part**” means the *Health Regulation 1996*, part 2,<sup>2</sup> as in force from time to time before its repeal by the *Health Amendment Regulation (No. 4) 1999*.’.
