## EQUITY AND FAIR TRADING LEGISLATION AMENDMENT REGULATION (No. 1) 2000

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#### Short title

**1.** This regulation may be cited as the *Equity and Fair Trading Legislation Amendment Regulation (No. 1) 2000.*
