STATE PENALTIES ENFORCEMENT REGULATION 2000

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PART 1—PRELIMINARY

Short title

1. This regulation may be cited as the *State Penalties Enforcement Regulation 2000*.

Commencement

2. This regulation commences on 27 November 2000.

Dictionary

3. The dictionary in schedule 6 defines words used in this regulation.

PART 2—INFRINGEMENT NOTICE OFFENCES ETC. FOR NOMINATED LAWS

Infringement notice offences and fines for nominated law

- **4.(1)** Schedules 1 to 5 (the "schedules") prescribe infringement notice offences and infringement notice fines for the Acts and regulations (the "nominated laws") mentioned in the schedules.¹
 - (2) For a nominated law mentioned in 1 of the schedules—
 - (a) an offence against a provision of the nominated law mentioned in the schedule, column 1 as limited by any description in the column,² is an offence to which the Act applies; and

Schedule 1 (Consumer related legislation), schedule 2 (Environmental legislation), schedule 3 (Transport legislation), schedule 4 (University legislation) and schedule 5 (Other legislation)

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(b) a number of penalty units mentioned in the schedule, column 2 opposite the offence is the fine payable for the offence under an infringement notice.

Administering authority for particular nominated laws

- **5.(1)** The administering authority for an infringement notice offence that is an offence against a provision of a nominated law, or an infringement notice about the offence, is the department or other agency within which the provision is administered.
 - (2) In this section—

"nominated law" does not include the following laws—

- (a) the *Electoral Act 1992*;
- (b) the Environmental Protection Act 1994;
- (c) the *Motor Accident Insurance Act 1994*;
- (d) the laws mentioned in schedule 4.

Administering authority for Electoral Act 1992

6. The administering authority for an infringement notice offence that is an offence against a provision of the *Electoral Act 1992*, or an infringement notice about the offence, is the Electoral Commission of Queensland.

Administering authority for Environmental Protection Act 1994

- **7.** The administering authority for an infringement notice offence that is an offence against a provision of the *Environmental Protection Act 1994*, or an infringement notice about the offence, is—
 - (a) for an infringement notice served by an employee of a local government, the local government; or
 - (b) otherwise, the agency within which the provision is administered.

Administering authority for Motor Accident Insurance Act 1994

8. The administering authority for an infringement notice offence that is an offence against a provision of the *Motor Accident Insurance Act 1994*, or an infringement notice about the offence, is the Motor Accident Insurance Commission

Administering authority for nominated law in sch 4

9. The administering authority for an infringement notice offence that is an offence against a provision of a nominated law in schedule 4,³ or an infringement notice about the offence, is the university to which the nominated law relates.

Authorised person for infringement notice for offence against nominated law

10. The person authorised to serve an infringement notice⁴ for an infringement notice offence that is an offence against a provision of a nominated law mentioned in schedule 1, 2, 3, 4 or 5 is the person specified for the law in the relevant schedule as the authorised person for service of infringement notices.

PART 3—INFRINGEMENT NOTICE OFFENCES ETC. FOR LOCAL LAWS AND BY-LAWS

Definition for pt 3

11. In this part—

"by-law" means a by-law made under the *Community Services* (Aborigines) Act 1984 or the *Community Services* (Torres Strait) Act 1984.

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Infringement notice offences and fines for local law or by-law

- **12.(1)** An offence against a provision of a local law or by-law that is not an offence against the person and for which a person may be punished by a maximum penalty of not more than 50 penalty units is an offence to which the Act applies (a "local law infringement notice offence").
- (2) The fine payable for a local law infringement notice offence under an infringement notice is, if the offence is otherwise punishable by a maximum penalty of—
 - (a) not more than 0.5 penalty units—the maximum penalty; or
 - (b) more than 0.5, but not more than 5, penalty units—\$37.50; or
 - (c) more than 5, but not more than 10, penalty units—1 penalty unit; or
 - (d) more than 10, but not more than 20, penalty units—2 penalty units; or
 - (e) more than 20, but not more than 30, penalty units—3 penalty units; or
 - (f) more than 30, but not more than 40, penalty units—4 penalty units; or
 - (g) more than 40, but not more than 50, penalty units—5 penalty units.

Administering authority for local law or by-law

- 13.(1) The administering authority for an infringement notice offence that is an offence against a provision of a local law, or an infringement notice about the offence, is the local government that made the local law.
- (2) The administering authority for an infringement notice offence that is an offence against a provision of a by-law, or an infringement notice about the offence, is the entity that made the by-law.

Authorised person for infringement notice for offence against local law or minor traffic offence or offence against by-law

14.(1) An authorised person for a local government under the *Local*

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Government Act 1993, section 1084⁵ is a person authorised to serve an infringement notice⁶ for—

- (a) an infringement notice offence that is an offence against a provision of a local law made by the local government; or
- (b) an infringement notice offence for the local government under the *Transport Operations (Road Use Management) Act 1995*, section 108.7
- (2) Each of the following people is a person authorised to serve an infringement notice for an infringement notice offence that is an offence against a provision of a by-law—
 - (a) a person appointed by the entity that made the by-law as an authorised officer under the *Community Services (Aborigines) Act* 1984 or the *Community Services (Torres Strait) Act* 1984;
 - (b) a person appointed by the entity that made the by-law as an aboriginal police officer under the *Community Services* (Aborigines) Act 1984 or an island police officer under the Community Services (Torres Strait) Act 1984;
 - (c) a police officer.

PART 4—IDENTIFYING PARTICULARS

Purpose of pt 4

15. This part states identifying particulars for infringement notices for infringement notice offences.

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Identifying particulars for alleged offender

- **16.(1)** This section does not apply to an infringement notice for an infringement notice offence involving a vehicle or animal.
- (2) For an infringement notice, the identifying particulars for an alleged offender are the following particulars in relation to the alleged offender—
 - (a) colour of hair and eyes;
 - (b) complexion;
 - (c) height;
 - (d) build;
 - (e) other noticeable distinguishing marks or features.

Identifying particulars for vehicle

- 17.(1) This section applies to an infringement notice for an infringement notice offence involving a vehicle.
- (2) For an infringement notice, the identifying particulars for the vehicle are the following particulars in relation to the vehicle—
 - (a) registration number;
 - (b) body type;
 - (c) when its registration expires;
 - (d) make;
 - (e) colour;
 - (f) if relevant, the number of passengers in the vehicle.
- (3) Subsection (2)(c) to (e) does not apply to a camera-detected offence if it is not practicable to work out the particulars mentioned in the provision from the image taken by the camera.

Identifying particulars for animal

- **18.(1)** This section applies to an infringement notice for an infringement notice offence involving an animal.
 - (2) The identifying particulars for the animal are the following particulars

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in relation to the animal—

- (a) species or breed;
- (b) colour;
- (c) sex;
- (d) identification tag, registration tag, collar, brand or tattoo;
- (e) electronically coded implant;
- (f) other noticeable distinguishing marks or features.

Identifying particulars for infringement notice for railway law

- 19.(1) This section applies to an infringement notice for an infringement notice offence that is an offence against a railway law if the offence happened during a journey on a railway.
- (2) For the Act, section 15(2)(d)(i), the identifying particulars for the infringement notice offence are the approximate times and stations between which the offence was alleged to have happened on the journey.
 - (3) In this section—

"railway law" means—

- (a) the Transport Operations (Passenger Transport) Act 1994; or
- (b) the Transport Infrastructure (Rail) Regulation 1996.

PART 5—OTHER PARTICULARS

Registering payment of infringement notice fine by instalments

20. The following are the particulars an administering authority must give to SPER for registration of an approved application to pay an infringement

notice fine by instalments8—

- (a) the full name, address and telephone number, if known, of the alleged offender;
- (b) the offence and the date and place of the offence;
- (c) the infringement notice number;
- (d) the amount of the infringement notice fine;
- (e) if the infringement notice offence involved a vehicle—the vehicle's registration number and State of registration or, for an unregistered vehicle, a statement that the vehicle was not registered;
- (f) any other known particulars that help identify the alleged offender.

Registering particulars of unpaid court ordered amount

- **21.** The following are the particulars a court registrar must give to SPER under the Act, section 349 for registration of an unpaid amount under a court order—
 - (a) the full name, address, and telephone number, if known, of the person ordered to pay the amount (the "relevant person");
 - (b) the relevant offence and the date and place of the offence;
 - (c) if the amount relates to an offence involving a vehicle—the vehicle's registration number and State of registration or, for an unregistered vehicle, a statement that the vehicle was not registered;
 - (d) the name of the court that made the order, when and where the order was made, and the unique identifier used by the court for the proceeding in relation to the relevant person;
 - (e) particulars of the original court order, including how much of the total amount to be registered is attributable to each part of the

Under the Act, section 24 (Registration of instalment payments for infringement notices), the administering authority must also notify SPER of the unpaid amount of the infringement notice fine.

court order;

(f) any other known particulars that help identify the relevant person.

Example for paragraph (e)—

When an unpaid amount is to be registered, it may consist of \$500 of the fine, \$400 for restitution, and \$100 for court costs.

Information to be provided if application to cancel enforcement order

- **22.** For the Act, section 57,¹⁰ the registrar may ask a person who applies under the Act for the cancellation of an enforcement order for an infringement notice offence¹¹ to give the registrar any of the following information the registrar considers necessary to help the registrar decide the application—
 - (a) the applicant's address—
 - (i) when the infringement notice offence allegedly happened; and
 - (ii) when the relevant infringement notice first came to the applicant's attention;
 - (b) if the applicant changed address before or after the infringement notice offence allegedly happened, when the change happened;
 - (c) if relevant, the address on the applicant's driver licence;
 - (d) how and when the relevant infringement notice came to the applicant's attention;
 - (e) if the applicant did not receive the infringement notice because of illness, particulars of the illness and a certificate, signed by the applicant's doctor, relating to the illness;
 - (f) any other reason the applicant did not receive the relevant infringement notice.

Applications are made under the Act, section 56 (Applications for cancellation of enforcement orders).

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Additional particulars for default certificate

- **23.** For the Act, section 135(h),¹²the following are additional particulars to be stated in a default certificate for an infringement notice offence—
 - (a) when and where the offence is alleged to have happened;
 - (b) the infringement notice number for the offence;
 - (c) the infringement notice fine for the offence;
 - (d) any other known particulars that help identify the alleged offender.

PART 6—MISCELLANEOUS

Proof of complaint for noise offence

- **24.(1)** This section applies in a proceeding under the Act in relation to an offence against any provision of the *Environmental Protection Regulation* 1998, section 6W to 6ZF involving the emission of a noise.
- (2) A certificate purporting to be signed by the relevant administering authority or the relevant authorised person stating a relevant nuisance complaint has been made for the emission under the regulation is evidence that a relevant nuisance complaint has been made for the emission under the regulation.
- (3) Subsection (2) does not require the certificate to state any matter for the relevant nuisance complaint mentioned in the regulation, section 6L(3).¹³

State entities from whom information may be sought under Act, s 152

25. For the Act, section 152,¹⁴ the following State entities are prescribed—

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- (a) the department within which the *Corrective Services Act 1988* is administered;
- (b) the department within which the *State Housing Act 1945* is administered;
- (c) the department within which the *Transport Operations (Road Use Management) Act 1995* is administered;
- (d) the Electoral Commission of Queensland;
- (e) the Residential Tenancies Authority.

Amnesty period

26. For the Act, section 167,¹⁵ the amnesty period is the 4 month period commencing on the commencement of that section.

Civil enforcement fee

27. For the Act, schedule $2,^{16}$ definition "civil enforcement fee", the fee prescribed for part 5^{17} is \$75.

Minimum instalment

28. For the Act, schedule 2, definition "minimum instalment", the minimum amount a person who may pay an amount by instalments must pay is \$60.

Registration fee

29. For the Act, schedule 2, definition "registration fee", the fee for registering an unpaid amount under the Act is \$44.

Threshold amount

30. For the Act, schedule 2, definition "threshold amount", the amount at or above which a person may apply to an administering authority for approval to pay an infringement notice fine by instalments is \$150.
