1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the Weapons Amendment Regulation (No. 1) 2002.

This regulation amends the Weapons Regulation 1996.

Amendment of s 39 (Construction of premises where collection 3 stored)

 - (a) for a category H weapon made permanently inoperable, the way the weapon is stored complies with section 60(3) and (4); or
 - (b) for a weapon other than a category H weapon
 - there are no more than 30 weapons at the premises where the weapon is; and
 - (ii) the way the weapon is stored complies with section 60(2)to (4).'.
