1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the Architects Regulation 2002.

2 Purpose and when regulation takes effect

- (1) This regulation is necessary to enable the appointment of the member of the Board of Architects of Queensland mentioned in section 82(2)(a)(i) of the Act to be made under the Acts Interpretation Act 1954, section 17(1).¹
- (2) Under the *Acts Interpretation Act 1954*, section 17(3), this regulation takes effect on the making of the regulation.

3 Prescribed school of architecture—Act, s 82

For section 82(2)(a)(i)² of the Act, each of the following is a prescribed school of architecture—

- School of Design and Built Environment, Queensland University of Technology
- School of Geography, Planning & Architecture, The University of Queensland.
