#### 1 Short title

#### '1 Area declared to be restricted area

'The community area of the Council of the Shire of Mornington.

# **'2** Prescribed quantity

- '(1) The prescribed quantity for the restricted area, other than the canteen or the lodge, is zero.
  - '(2) The prescribed quantity for the canteen is—
    - (a) for beer in which the concentration of alcohol is no more than 4%—any quantity; and
    - (b) for beer other than beer mentioned in paragraph (a)—zero; and
    - (c) for spirits or wine—zero.
  - '(3) The prescribed quantity for the lodge is—
    - (a) for beer or spirits—any quantity; and
    - (b) for wine—750 ml.

## '(4) In this section—

- **"canteen"** means the licensed premises known as the Lelka Murrin Pub at Mission Road, Gununa, Mornington Island.
- **"lodge"** means the licensed premises known as Birri Fishing Lodge at Birri Road, Mornington Island.'.
