1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Building and Construction Industry Payments Amendment Regulation (No. 1)* 2004.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on 1 October 2004.

This regulation amends the *Building and Construction Industry Payments Regulation 2004.*

'3 Adjudication qualification—Act, s 111

'For section 111(2)(b) of the Act, the following are prescribed for an adjudication qualification—

- (a) the name of the qualification is Certificate in Adjudication;
- (b) a body mentioned in schedule 1, part 1 may issue the qualification;

- (c) the name of the adjudication competency to be achieved is Building and Construction Industry Payments Adjudication;
- (d) the elements that must be successfully completed are the elements mentioned in schedule 1, part 2.'.
