1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Recreation Areas Management (Postponement) Regulation 2007*.

2 Postponed commencement of uncommenced provisions

- (1) The period before automatic commencement, under the *Acts Interpretation Act 1954*, section 15DA(2), of the postponed law is extended to the end of 2 May 2008.
- (2) In this section—

postponed law means the provisions of the *Recreation Areas Management Act 2006* that are not in force.

Editor's note—

The postponed law now automatically commences on 3 May 2008.

3 Expiry

This regulation expires on 4 May 2008.
