1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Maritime and Other Legislation Amendment (Postponement) Regulation 2007*.

2 Postponed commencement of particular uncommenced provisions

- (1) The period before automatic commencement under the *Acts Interpretation Act 1954*, section 15DA(2) of the postponed law is extended to the end of 17 May 2008.

- (2) In this section—

postponed law means an uncommenced provision of the *Maritime and Other Legislation Amendment Act 2006* stated in the schedule.

3 Expiry

This regulation expires on 19 May 2008.
