This regulation may be cited as the *Water and Other Legislation Amendment Regulation (No. 2) 2007*.

‘60A Prescribed organisation and program—Act, s 1014

- ‘(1) Cotton Australia Limited is prescribed as the organisation that may provide the accredited farm management system program mentioned in subsection (2).
- ‘(2) The farm management system program called ‘Cotton Best Management Practices Program’ and administered by Cotton Australia Limited is prescribed as an accredited farm management system program.
- ‘(3) In this section—

Cotton Australia Limited means Cotton Australia Limited ACN 054 122 879.’.

This part amends the *Fisheries Regulation 1995*.

14 Amendment of s 57 (Resource allocation authority)

Section 57(1)(a), ‘table 1, item 3(b) or (c) or table 4, item 3(b) or (c)’—

omit, insert—

‘table 1, item 3(b), (c) or (d) or table 4, item 3(b), (c), (d) or (e)’.

15 Amendment of s 79 (Carrying out particular work in declared fish habit area)

(1) Section 79, heading, ‘habit’—

omit, insert—

'habitat'.

(2) Section 79—

insert—

‘(2) Subsection (3) applies for carrying out, in a declared fish habitat area, development mentioned in both of the following—

(a) the Planning Act, schedule 8, part 2, table 1, item 3(d) or table 4, item 3(d) or (e);

(b) schedule 1, table 3 of the minor impact works code.

‘(3) A person may carry out the development in the declared fish habitat area only if the person holds a resource allocation authority authorising the person to interfere with the declared fish habitat area.’.

‘table 1, item 3(b), (c) or (d) or table 4, item 3(b), (c), (d) or (e)’.

20 Amendment of sch 17 (Definitions)

Schedule 17, part 2—

insert—

‘**minor impact works code** means the code for the Planning Act made by the department, called ‘Code for self-assessable development—Minor impact works in a declared fish habitat area or involving the removal, destruction or damage of marine plants’, numbered MP06.’.
