1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Superannuation (State Public Sector) Amendment (Postponement) Regulation 2008*.

2 Postponed commencement of uncommenced provisions

- (1) The period before automatic commencement, under the *Acts Interpretation Act 1954*, section 15DA(2), of the postponed law is extended to the end of 28 February 2009.
- (2) In this section—

postponed law means the uncommenced provisions of the *Superannuation (State Public Sector) Amendment Act 2007*.

Editor's note—

The postponed law now automatically commences on 1 March 2009.

3 Expiry

This regulation expires on 2 March 2009.
