Part 1 Preliminary

1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Education (Queensland Studies Authority) and Other Legislation Amendment Regulation (No. 1) 2008*.

Part 2 Amendment of Education (Queensland Studies Authority) Regulation 2002

2 Regulation amended in pt 2

This part amends the *Education (Queensland Studies Authority) Regulation 2002*.

3 Amendment of s 3AA (Meaning of *contributing studies* for QCE)

- (1) Section 3AA(1)(a), ‘authority’—
omit, insert—
‘approved’.
- (2) Section 3AA(1)(b) and (c)—
omit.
- (3) Section 3AA(1)(d) to (j)—
renumber as section 3AA(1)(b) to (h).

4 Amendment of s 4 (External senior examinations available)

Section 4, ‘a school’—

omit, insert—

‘an approved’.

5 Amendment of s 5 (Persons eligible to take examination)

- (1) Section 5(3)(b) and (5), ‘authority subject’—

omit, insert—

‘approved subject’.
- (2) Section 5(6), definition *corresponding authority subject*—

omit.
- (3) Section 5(6)—

insert—

‘***corresponding approved subject***, for an examination subject, means the approved subject that is substantially the same as the examination subject.’.

6 Omission of pt 3, div 1

Part 3, division 1—

omit.

7 Renumbering of pt 3, divs 2 and 3

Part 3, divisions 2 and 3—

renumber as part 3, divisions 1 and 2.

8 Amendment of s 38E (Requirement to record credits for contributing studies in a person’s student account)

Section 38E(2)(a), ‘an examination subject’—

omit, insert—

‘an approved subject that is also an examination subject’.

9 Amendment of s 39A (Completion of contributing studies)

Section 39A(3)(a), before ‘examination’—

omit, insert—

‘approved subjects that are also’.

10 Amendment of s 41E (Purpose of div 6)

Section 41E, ‘3AA(1)(j)’—

omit, insert—

‘3AA(1)(h)’.

11 Amendment of ss 48A and 49B

Sections 48A(d)(vi) and 49B(c)(vi), ‘3AA(1)(a), (c), (g) or (h)’—

omit, insert—

‘3AA(1)(a), (e) or (f)’.

12 Amendment of s 52 (Eligibility for ranking for tertiary entrance)

Section 52(a), ‘authority’—

omit, insert—

‘tertiary entrance’.

13 Amendment of s 55 (List measuring comparative achievement)

Section 55(1), ‘authority subjects’—

omit, insert—

‘tertiary entrance subjects’.

14 Insertion of new s 76B

After section 76A—

insert—

'76B Particular guidelines about tertiary entrance subjects to be available on authority's website

- ‘(1) This section applies to a guideline mentioned in the definition *tertiary entrance subject* in schedule 2.
 - ‘(2) The authority must ensure the guideline is available to be viewed, in full, by the public on the authority’s website.

- ‘(3) This section does not limit section 76.’.

15 Amendment of s 80 (Tertiary entrance functions)

Section 80—

insert—

- (2) However, the authority may make or amend a guideline mentioned in the definition *tertiary entrance subject* in schedule 2 only with the written approval of the Minister.'

16 Insertion of new pt 12, div 4

After section 108—

insert—

'Division 4

Transitional provision for Education (Queensland Studies Authority) and Other Legislation Amendment Regulation (No. 1) 2008

'109 Authority subjects

- ‘(1) This section applies—

- (a) if, on the commencement, a guideline mentioned in the definition *tertiary entrance subject* in schedule 2 has not been made; and
 - (b) until the guideline is made.
- ‘(2) A school subject that, immediately before the commencement, was an authority subject is taken to be a tertiary entrance subject.
- ‘(3) In this section—
authority subject has the meaning given in schedule 2 as it was in force immediately before the commencement.
commencement means the commencement of this section.’.

17 Amendment of sch 2 (Dictionary)

- (1) Schedule 2, definitions *authority registered subject*, *authority subject* and *examination subject*—
omit.
- (2) Schedule 2—
insert—

‘**approved subject** means a school subject for which there is an approved syllabus.

examination subject means an approved subject for which an external senior examination is available under section 4.

tertiary entrance subject means an approved subject stated in a guideline.’.
- (3) Schedule 2, definition *appropriate entity*, ‘authority’—
omit, insert—

‘tertiary entrance’.
- (4) Schedule 2, definition *assessing school*, paragraph (b), from ‘of’—
omit, insert—

‘approved subjects.’.

18 Regulation amended in pt 3

This part amends the *Education (General Provisions) Regulation 2006*.

19 Amendment of s 12 (Liquor not to be taken onto premises in dry places)

Section 12(2), definition *dry place*—

omit, insert—

‘*dry place* see the *Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Communities (Justice, Land and Other Matters) Act 1984*, section 27.’.

20 Regulation amended in pt 4

This part amends the *Education (Queensland College of Teachers) Regulation 2005*.

21 Amendment of s 14 (Returning to teaching condition—professional development program)

Section 14(3)—

omit.

Amendment of Vocational Education, Training and Employment Regulation 2000

22 Regulation amended in pt 5

This part amends the *Vocational Education, Training and Employment Regulation 2000*.

23 Amendment of s 30K (Tuition fee exemptions for government funded subjects)

Section 30K(1)(b), ‘authority subjects, or authority registered subjects,—

omit, insert—

‘approved subjects’.
